Being a Voice and **Bringing Awareness**

In Newaygo County, we find ourselves in two crises that I would argue are relatively unknown to a large percentage of the population—or certainly the magnitude of the problem. What two problems am I referring to? Meth and human trafficking. Not two issues we typically want to dwell on or think about in relation to our day-today lives. Yet, both are ravaging our community in ways that must be dealt with before the devastation multiplies further.

Human trafficking has entered our churches, schools, homes, and families with ease and accessibility. This happens under the very noses of well-intended adults who, sadly, lack the knowledge, awareness, and tenacity to fight the overwhelming beast of digital access to our kids through cell phones, gaming apps, and social media. Human trafficking is, as many professionals are trying to scream from the rooftops, more rampant and widespread than most of us can even understand, given the ever-changing digital realm and unceasing attempts to trap unsuspecting prey.

In the first two months of 2023, Newaygo County felt the impact of this seemingly invisible crisis. Not one, but two, cases of a student from Grant Public Schools coming forward occurred. In both instances, a female student had taken part in the prevention education curriculum that caused her to pause and realize that she was being groomed and trafficked.
