A LITTLE BIT GOES A LONG WAY...



With the rising costs of food, many of our neighbors are struggling with food insecurity. The Love INC Community Food Pantry is experiencing a tremendous increase in the number of shoppers. In the first half of 2022 the pantry served 3,021 people. In the first half of 2023 we have served 5,987 people. That is a 98% increase!

The Love INC food pantry is open from 10am to 2pm on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, as well as Tuesday evenings from 5pm to 7pm for those who are working or unable to come during the day. Each shopper selects the foods their family needs and will use. The amount of food that each shopper gets is determined by family size. Each shopper is assisted by a pantry volunteer.

Would your church, small group, business, or family consider helping us care for our neighbors by hosting a food drive or picking up a few extra items when shopping for your family?

The following is a list of ideas for food drives:

- School's Out Breakfast Drive:
 - Dry cereals, oatmeal, muffin mixes, breakfast bars, pancake mix, syrup, jelly.
- Pasta Night or Pizza night:
 - Pasta - any shape/size, pasta sauce, lasagna noodles. Pizza fixings - pepperoni (shelf stable), sliced olives, pizza sauce, parmesan cheese.
- Christmas in July
- Personal care items:
 - Dish soap, laundry detergents, shampoo & conditioner, women's feminine products, and both men's & women's deodorants.
- Meal Sides:
 - Helper style, Knorr rice or pasta sides. Mashed potatoes - packets or boxed. Boxed potatoes - au gratin, hash browns, scalloped, etc.
- Taco / Chili Night:
 - Season packets, taco shells, taco tortillas, enchilada sauce, chili beans, canned, diced tomatoes, refried beans, diced chilies, salsas, chili tomatoes, chili ready beans, dried pinto beans.
- Have a "Souper Day" or "Souper Bowl party":
 - Condensed soups for cooking, chicken noodle, chicken rice, low-sodium soups, ready-to-eat soups, dry packaged soups, meal soups.
- Condiments & Cooking:
 - Mustard, ketchup, relish, salad dressings, sugar, flour, condensed milk, gravy - canned or packets, BBQ sauce, baking powder, baking soda, salt.
- Fruits & More:
 - Any variety of canned fruits, fruit cups, applesauce, fruit juice - bottles or small boxes, raisins.
